Travel baseball provides a higher level of training and competition for talented and motivated baseball players who are willing to commit time to the improvement of their skills in a team focused environment. It requires a commitment from players and parents to attend practices, league games, and tournaments.

Who is Eligible to Participate?

All baseball players who attend a school located within St. Cloud School District 742 boundaries (public or parochial), or who has a parent or legal guardian who resides within District 742 boundaries will be eligible for a team. In addition, if a child is not able to meet these boundary restrictions, individual requests for exemptions will be considered.

Gopher State Travel League Play with Surrounding Communities

St. Cloud Blue Sox teams participate in the MYAS Gopher State Baseball Travel League with other area communities.

In 2010, teams in the Gopher State West Division included Sauk Rapids, Sartell, Foley, Becker, Big Lake, Delano, Monticello, Rogers, St. Michael/Albertville, Melrose, Alexandria, and Buffalo.

Schedule for Summer 2011

Practices for the travel baseball season will begin in April 2011 with league games beginning in May (or June for the 15-year old team, depending on high school schedules). Practices and games will not conflict with junior high or high school baseball schedules. **The season typically concludes in mid-July** with travel league play-offs, and/or a state tournament. The commitment for a player on a travel baseball team is typically 2-3 nights per week for practices and league games, and 3-4 weekend tournaments.
